EDUCATION

- **Digital Connections [N1457]:** Provides families with the capacity and resources to access and further their learning in the classroom, workforce and beyond.
- **Once Upon a Month [ONCEMO]:** Delivers age-appropriate children's books to families each month to stimulate curiosity, language development and learning skills.

INCOME

- **Dollars for College [N1361]:** Enables kids to grow up with a college savings account, substantially increasing their likelihood of attending college and graduating.
- **Pathways to Economic Mobility [FINIS]:** Provides families the tools and know-how to increase savings, improve credit scores, reduce debt and avoid predatory lending products.

- **Family Connects [N1444]:** A nurse home visiting program for postpartum caregivers that focuses on maternal and infant health and wellbeing.
- **North Texas Summer and Supper Council [DALSUM]:** Supports community organizations that provide nutritious meals to children during the summer months.

HOUSING

- **Homelessness Prevention [N1402]:** Encourages housing stability through a continuum of services, including eviction prevention, rental assistance and support for affordable housing.

SOCIAL INNOVATION

- **Social Innovation [856]:** A suite of programs that support local social entrepreneurs who are implementing creative solutions to challenges in education, income and health.
